We have prepared a special map highlighting the main buildings and public spaces of the area: not only the new architectures but also the public green areas and some historic buildings that remind us of the layered history of this place. Our route is inspired by the three Transition Pathways of the DUT Partnership – 15-minute City, Circular Urban Economies and Positive Energy District – to show how Porta Nuova District represents a concrete laboratory of European urban transformation. To these three pathways we have added a fourth one, dedicated to historic buildings, to connect memory and innovation. This will therefore be not only a visit, but also a moment of reflection: while walking through Porta Nuova Districts, we will see how the major themes of European urban policies take shape in the spaces, the buildings, and the daily life of the city
