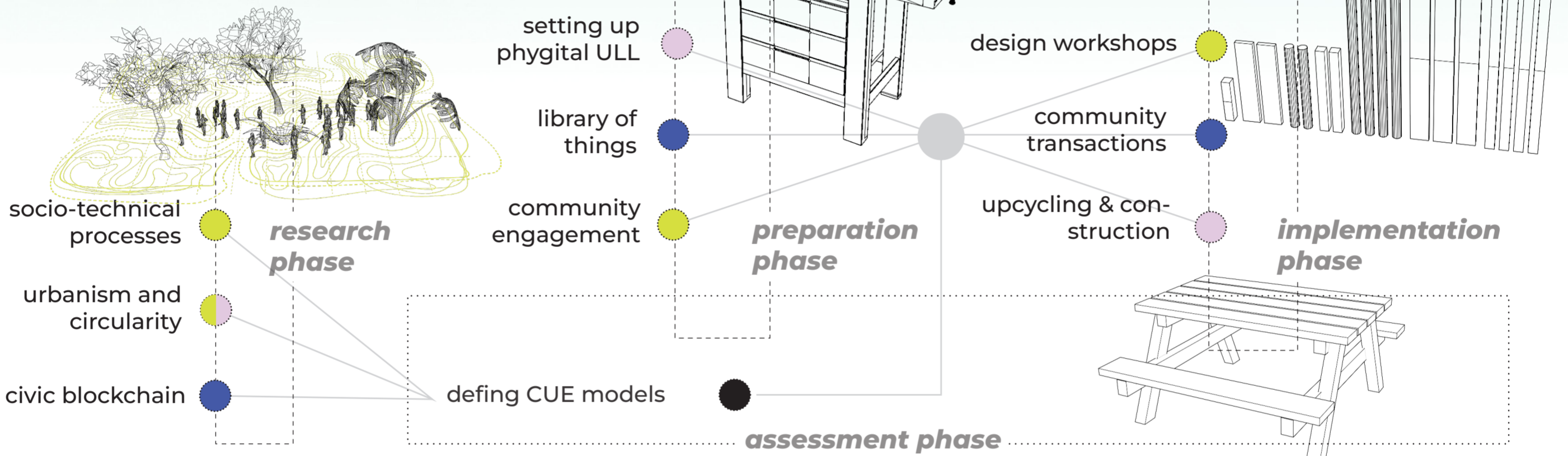




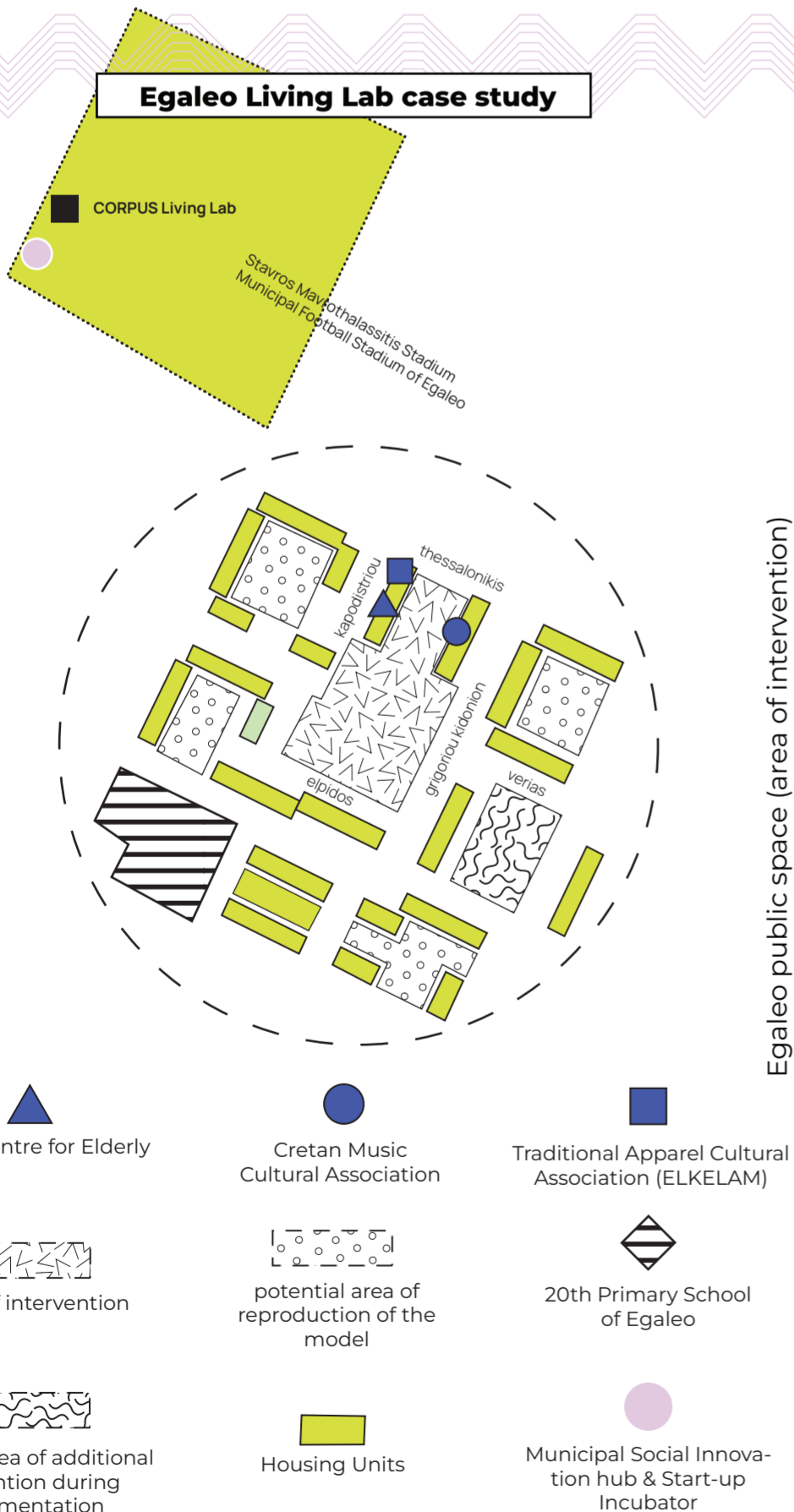
Phygital Models of cooperation in the retrofitting of public space

Co.R.Pu.S. aims to conduct research on alternative processes of retrofitting public space at neighborhood level, grounded on Circular Urban Economies (CUE) through involvement of local stakeholders and citizens. Having as its main challenge the revival of degraded public space in the periphery of the city, the project will investigate alternative ways of cooperation through the concept of Urban Living Lab (ULL) as a diffusing entity of CUE. Two case studies of ULLs (park of Public Housing Complex in Egaleo/Greece and micro-circular economies in Turin/Italy) will be set up, in order to design semi-permanent urban equipment through participatory processes, upcycling techniques and the development of digitally enabled systems (civic blockchain) to promote circularity of materials, services and goods.

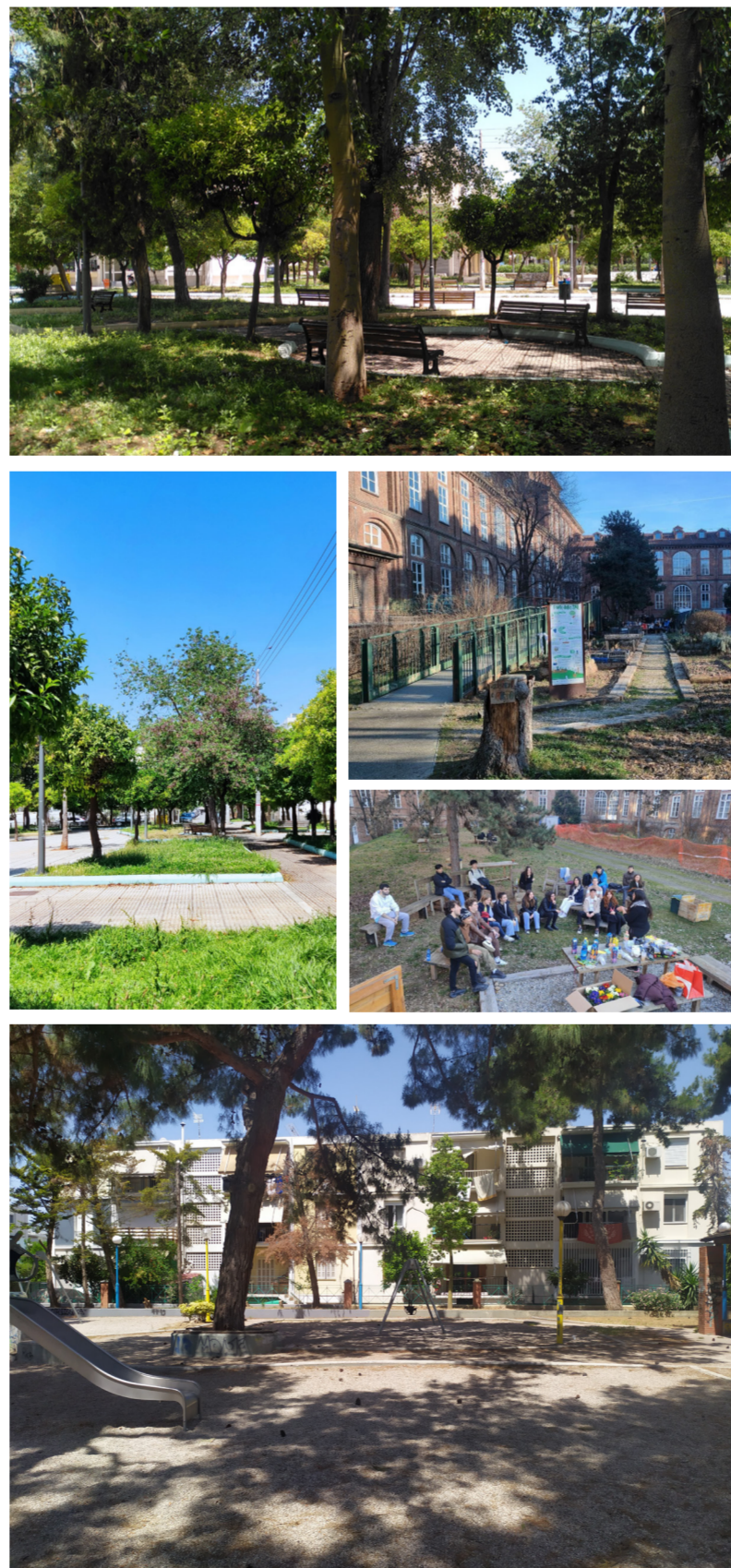

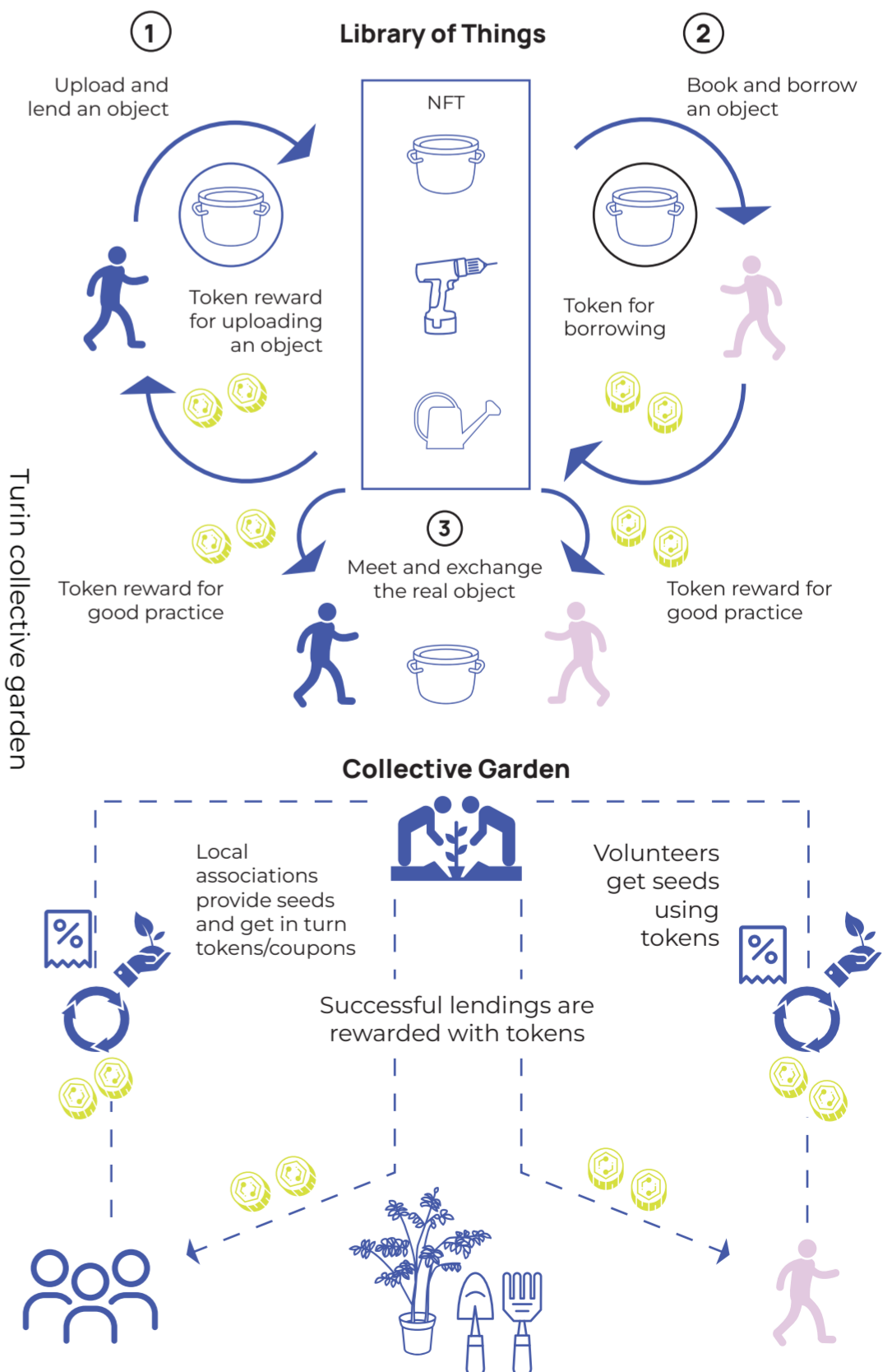
