

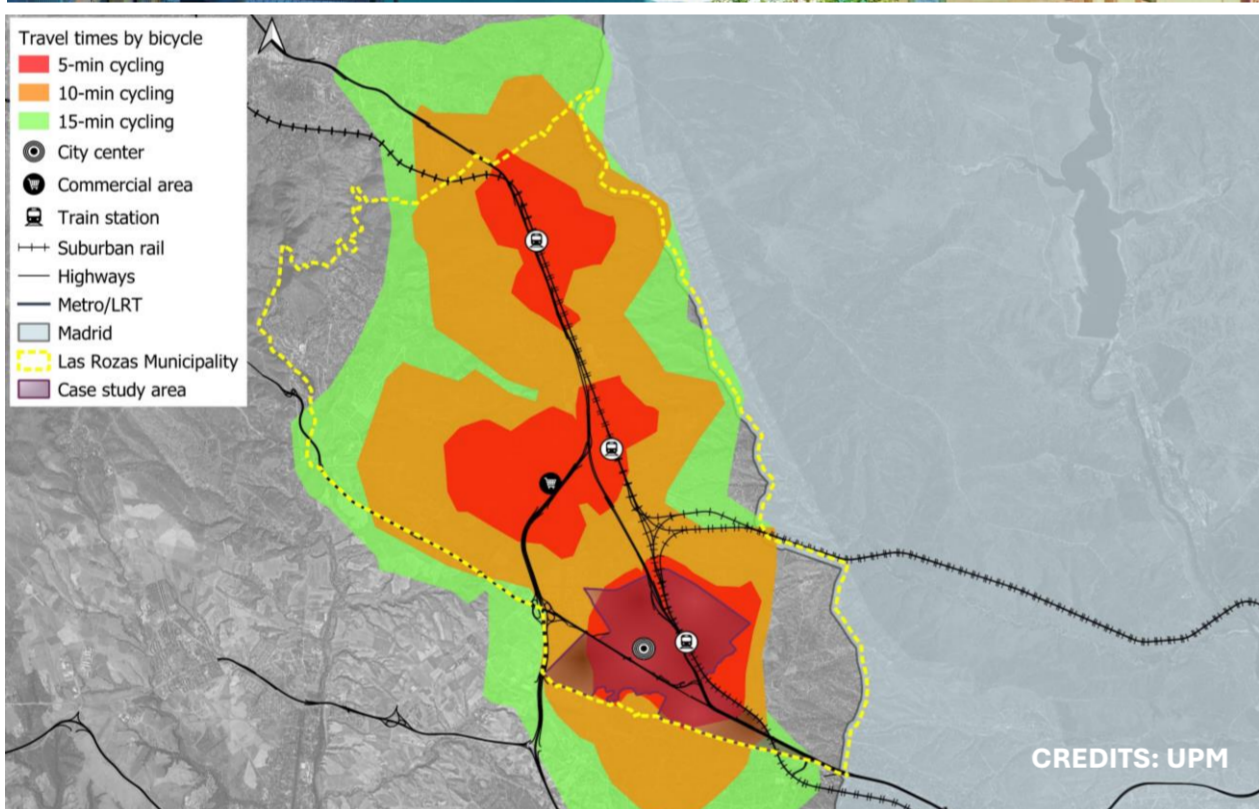

WHAT IS FORTHCOMING ABOUT?

Funded by the Driving Urban Transitions (DUT) Partnership, the FORTHCOMING project (FOsteRing THE City Of proximity through Maas INteGration) will **develop and test data-driven and user-centric 15-minute city models for suburban contexts**, learning from central city best practices.

Outskirts' specific issues in relation to the 4 pillars (**density, proximity, diversity, and digitalisation**) of the 15-minute city model mean that the uptake of the 15-minute city in low and mid-density zones requires adjustments and potentially different implementation procedures.



OBJECTIVE. Foster the successful transfer of central city strategies to the suburbs, boosting the transition to climate-neutral, liveable, and inclusive cities.



KEY FEATURES. Adoption of ICT MaaS & LaaS tools that provide solutions to site-specific problems, supporting the development of the 15-minute city model in peripheries.



MAIN OUTPUTS. A 'Portfolio of Successful 15minC Strategies in Urban Areas', as well as a '15minC Implementation Guidebook for Suburban Areas'.
