Sustainable and Climate-Neutral Cities for Inclusive and Equitable Urban Futures-Urban Europe Research Alliance CONFERENCE 2025

The Day 2 will be dedicated to the UERA Conference 2025. Scientific presentations are aimed at clarifying innovative approaches and at the nexus of climate neutrality, sustainability, and social equity in urban settings. Submissions may take the form of theoretical frameworks, empirical case studies, or visionary proposals aimed at exploring urban sustainability paradigms.

Authors wishing to submit a paper or a work in progress must prepare an abstract in English, ranging from 200 to 300 words. Abstracts are welcome to advance new planning and governance perspectives and strategies for Europe's city-regions, generating a debate on challenges and opportunities in the context of Sustainable and Climate-Neutral Cities for Inclusive and Equitable Urban Futures promoting potential pathways for EU's spatial policy by scrutinizing critical aspects. UERA Conference 2025 will provide a forum for partnership and consolidation of collaboration for future Urban Europe Research Alliances and policies. All submissions will undergo a review process by the Scientific Committee.

Abstracts must articulate their connection to the conference themes, delineating the rationale, objectives, methodologies employed, and validation through relevant case studies (if applicable). Additionally, key findings and conclusions should be clearly stated. Authors are required to indicate their preferred mode of presentation (oral or poster). It is mandatory for at least one author to be present in person during the presentation.
